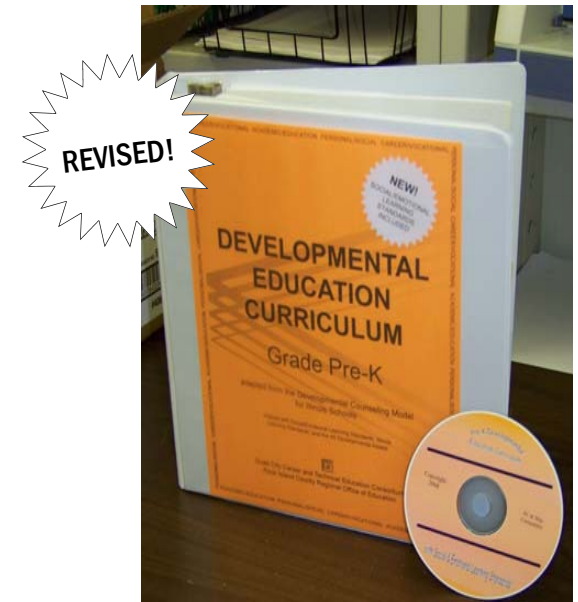

To help students grow more independent and responsible, the developmental guidance philosophy and model were created. The Developmental Guidance Model is a program that is proactive and preventive. It includes a life skills curriculum aimed at helping students

develop skills in decision making, coping, setting goals, maintaining satisfying relationships and assuming personal responsibility for their lives. Its goal is to enable all students to realize their full potential in their chosen careers.

The First Curriculum

In 1998 a committee of counselors met and developed the K-12 Development Curriculum cross-walked with the Illinois Learning Standards.

The Newly Revised Curriculum

The newly revised series now includes a Pre-K book. All books are now cross-walked with the Illinois Learning Standards, the Social/Emotional Standards and the 40 Assets.
