In order to earn an Illinois High School Equivalency Certificate, you must take and pass the Constitution test as required by Illinois Compiled Statutes School Code (105 ILCS 5/27-3).

There is no fee to take the Constitution Test.

****If you took the Constitution test in 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade in Illinois and passed, you do NOT have to take the test. You must contact your high school, ask them to mail us an Official letter of proof that you passed the test on school letterhead or an Official Transcript which shows you've passed the test. Faxed documents are NOT accepted.**

Taking the Test—

You must have the proper Valid Government issued Photo Identification, or you will not be able to take the test.

The Constitution test is a federally regulated test. All certified testing sites are required to ensure accurate identification of each person being tested & Photo identification is required for this purpose. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.

Scheduling a Test

Please call (309)736-1111 to schedule your test at the Rock Island County Regional Office of Education.

Testing time is every Friday at 9:00 AM, unless said day falls on a Holiday. If you are 15 minutes late for your appointment, you will NOT be able to test and will have to reschedule. (See Cancellation Policy below)

Cancellation Policy—

If you are unable to take the test on the day reserved for you, you must call our office to cancel before 4:30pm the day prior to the test. If you fail to do so, you will not be allowed to reschedule the test for 21 days. If you have any questions regarding our policy, or if you need to cancel the test, please call our office at (309) 736-1111.

Items at the Testing Site—

Constitution test takers are not permitted to bring purses, tote/book bags, pagers, cell phones, Bluetooth, portable music players, hand-held electronics, calculators, food/drink items, textbooks, dictionaries, notebooks, supplies, pens, pencils, jackets or coats, hats, or other nonessential items to the testing room. We will provide locked storage for your items or you may return items to your vehicle. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Obtaining Results—

If you take the test administered by computer at our facility, you will receive your results immediately. If you took the test on paper at Black Hawk College, you can obtain your test results via phone or in person at our office, after 10 business days.
